### : Uganda National Museum.

### : The Bahá'í Temple.

Then later on, visit The Bahá'í Temple in Kampala, Uganda, also known as the Mother Temple of Africa, is a significant religious and architectural landmark. It is the only Bahá'í House of Worship on the African continent, one of eight continental temples spread around the world. The temple is situated on Kikaya Hill on the outskirts of Kampala, offering panoramic views of the surrounding area.



### : The Gadhafi Mosque.

The Gaddafi Mosque, officially known as the Uganda National Mosque, is one of the most prominent Islamic religious sites in Kampala, Uganda. Located at Kampala Hill in the Old Kampala area of the city, the mosque was completed in 2006 with funding from the Libyan leader the late Colonel Muammar Gaddafi, hence its informal name. It holds significant importance not only as a place of worship but also as a cultural and community center.





## : Nakasero Market & Owino Markets.

Then later in the afternoon, you will visit the two main markets i.e Nakasero and Owino. Nakasero Market is one of the most vibrant and bustling markets in Kampala, Uganda. Located in the heart of the city, this market is a hub for fresh produce, ranging from fruits and vegetables to spices and meats. The lower section of the market is primarily open-air and features numerous stalls selling fresh food. The upper section, housed in a more structured setting, includes vendors offering a variety of goods such as hardware, textiles, and electronics. Owino Market, also known as St. Balikuddembe Market, is one of the largest and busiest markets in East Africa. Located in Kampala, it covers several acres and offers a wide range of products, from second-hand clothing and household items to traditional herbal medicines and crafts. Owino is famous for its maze-like alleys, vibrant atmosphere, and the ability to bargain for nearly everything. The market is a vital part of Kampala's economy, providing livelihoods for thousands of vendors and offering a real taste of local life and culture. Owino Market is not just a place to shop but a cultural experience, reflecting the diversity and energy of Uganda.
